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Supply List

We'll discuss supplies before each topic. Examples will be shown so you'll know what to look for. Bring tools that you already have, rather than buying new, until you know what will work best for you.

On Day 1 you'll need:

- Notebook/sketchbook, writing implement
- Cotton Cloth - any natural, woven fiber will work as long as it's fairly sturdy:
 - Scraps of muslin, quilting cotton, denim, etc.; patterned or solid (to use or share; don't buy new fabric if you don't happen to have scraps)
 - Approx. ½ yard muslin or broadcloth; solid (white, tan, or light-to medium colored; can be old sheets or such)
- Garment to mend or decorate such as jeans, shirt, or jacket
- Firm object such as plastic container, lid, thin board, stiff cardboard, old book, or phonebook to place inside of "object to be mended" while mending (it will likely get poked by the needle)
- Embroidery floss (one or two small skeins of DMC or similar to start with, in colors to coordinate or contrast with your "garment to be mended"; more will be available in class)
- Scissors or snips (small and sharp for cutting embroidery floss; any sharp scissors will work)
- Thimble (loaners will be available in class)
- Embroidery hoop (6" – 12" diameter; loaners will be available in class)
- Hand sewing needles: embroidery, crewel, sashiko, or similar (long needle with elongated "eye" and sharp point; loaners will be available in class)
- Optional: Needle threader, Work lamp (also bring extension cord), Magnifying glass, or any other "vision-assisters".
