SPECIAL EVENTS

ART & CRAFT FAIR

This is one of two annual fundraising events and draws the largest crowd over a 3-day period. Roughly 1200 local community members attend this fair, with over 40 artists offering their wares.

DEMO NIGHT

Demo Night features 10-12 artists showcasing their work and demonstrating processes in blacksmithing, wood carving, ceramics and more. This event is one of the biggest draws to the public and our membership and attracts 300+ visitors.

BE OUR GUEST! NIGHT - NEW

The Art Center is opening its doors to the public and waiving admission fee every Wednesday from 4-7pm. By doing this, working professionals and community members can view the exhibitions after normal business hours at no cost.

YOUTH & FAMILY

SPRING ART WEEK

Spring Art Week offers students the opportunity to observe professional working artists as they create, explain their process, and inspire students. Eight stations are offered and include blacksmithing, pastel, spray painting, collage, film, clay sculpture, figure drawing and ceramics. These 1-2 hour demonstrations are for students in grades Pre-K through 12th. Everyone is invited; public and private schools, special education and home school students.

HOLIDAY BREAK DAY CAMP

Full day art camp is available to children and families to participate in while school is out. These day camps offer students a variety of hands-on activities and art education options.

SUMMER ART CAMP

The Art Center's Summer Art Camp provides children ages 5-12 the opportunity to explore the many forms of art and discover their own creativity through clay, painting, origami, yoga, printmaking, film, theater, music, dance and more.

FAMILY SATURDAY ACTIVITIES SERIES - NEW

The Art Center offers families opportunities to create together! These events are holiday-centered, and offer kiddos and their parents or grandparents the chance to create gifts and decorations related to Valentine's Day, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Halloween, Thanksgiving & Christmas. Event dates fall the Saturday before the specified holiday. Participants leave with a hand-crafted gift or decoration.

PROGRAMS

VISITING ARTIST LECTURE SERIES

Offered quarterly, nationally-recognized artists come to The Art Center to provide 1 hour lectures that cover their style, techniques and inspirations with artists and art enthusiasts.

ARTABILITY: ARTS FOR ALL

For over 10 years, Artability: Arts for All has provided art experiences and education to youth and individuals with disabilities. This program serves 250 adults with special needs, and over 100 youth per month.

RECURRING EVENTS

FIRST FRIDAYS

The Art Center's First Friday exhibitions attract between 300-500 visitors in one night each month and serves as the official opening of the new exhibitions being offered in our galleries. This is a free event. Refreshments provided, and beer and wine are available to purchase.

FREE TUESDAYS

Consider sponsoring The Art Center's Free Tuesdays! Every Tuesday, our doors are open and admission is free to the general public to come see our exhibitions offered in 3 galleries.

FIGURE DRAWING NIGHTS

The Art Center is offering drop-in figure drawing sessions without pressure or obligation of the classroom to members and the general public.

OVER THE HUMP HAPPY HOURS - NEW

The Art Center's Over The Hump Happy Hours are held on Wednesday evenings from 4-7pm. This weekly event helps local working professionals get up over the "hump", and offers the chance for evening visitation to explore our galleries and exhibits.
