OIL PAINTING SUPPLIES LIST:

1. Primed canvases: (can be either stretched or on board).
canvas size: 11x14 (4 quantity)
2. Brushes: 3 flat hog bristle brushes, #2, #4, and a #6 (no synthetic).
1 sable brush for signing the painting, #2 (optional).
3. Oil paint:
 - Cadmium Red Light
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Dioxazine Purple
 - Cobalt Blue
 - Cerulean Blue
 - Cadmium or Barium Yellow medium
 - Naples Yellow
 - Lemon Yellow (optional)
 - Yellow Ochre
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Sap Green
 - Viridian Green
 - Ivory black (optional)
 - Titanium White, large tube
4. Palette or disposable oil palette paper pad: 12x16.
5. Palette knife.
6. Odorless mineral spirits (Home Depot, cheapest) or odorless turpentine to thin the paint and for cleaning brushes.
A small container to pour the turpentine into.
7. Roll of paper towels and a few plastic bags for clean up.
8. A portable table easel or a standing easel (supplied by The Art Center).
